My brother Knights, again, we are in the happy season of vacation time. Vacations take on many forms for all of us. For so many it is an opportunity for families to gather together in a low key manner to enjoy one another's company with summertime activities. It needn't be a trip to the Bahamas or any exotic vacation spot. It could just simply be spending a couple of days at some vacation area nearby, or simply meeting at the beach on the Jersey shore.

I personally remember from my youth spending many happy days with my family on Cape Cod or at some local lake such as Lake Taconic in Upstate New York. Swimming, home-cooked meals eaten outside, lounging around on the beach or summertime games with relatives all were opportunities to share the love of family life and to know our belongingness and acceptance with one another. It's really great that as a result of a summer vacation with family, one is allowed to feel good about being amongst one's own and renew relationships.

No during the month of June and especially on the Feast of The Body and Blood of Christ, we must give many thanks to God for allowing us to remain with Him, the opportunity to make atonement to Him and to express to Him our joy at having Him so close to us as well as to listen to His love for you and me. Our Lord and our God is in the Tabernacle. Just as with our families and friends we express our feelings through external signs and actions. The veneration for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is expressed in many ways—Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, processions, prayer before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, genuflections that are real acts of faith and adoration.

When I was a real little boy I remember how terribly afraid I was of thunderstorms. I used to become panicky & hysterical as only a child could be. I remember so vividly one summer afternoon when a thunderstorm was rolling through the Hudson Valley. It didn't help at all with the stories my parents would tell me that the crashes of thunder were simply the old Dutch elves bowling in the Catskills. I was still very scared. So my father gently took me by the hand, and we went to the back porch. He sat me down with him on the floor and put his arms around me while he described the storm to me, and we looked out the screen door. We talked about the lightening bolts and how they clear the air. He told me how to deal with this and to respect the storms and where to go when they happen.

The church reminds us during the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ and throughout June of the need to express thanksgiving and joy because God has wanted to remain with us in order to feed us and strengthen us, so that we may never feel alone, so that we could deal with our fears and not become hysterical. The Holy Eucharist is the *viaticum*, the food for the long journey of our days on earth towards the goal of true Life. Jesus accompanies us and strengthens us during holy mass, where our life is like a shadow compared to the reality that awaits us. Oh yes, everybody, there is a clear message our Lord has to us who come to mass to be touched by Him, but especially : *Wait to you see what I have prepared for you in heaven!*

Although we celebrate this feast only once a year, the Church really proclaims this most happy truth everyday: Jesus gives Himself to us as our food, and He remains in our Tabernacles to be for us the strength and the hope of a new life, a life without end and without limit. It is a mystery which is ever alive and ever new

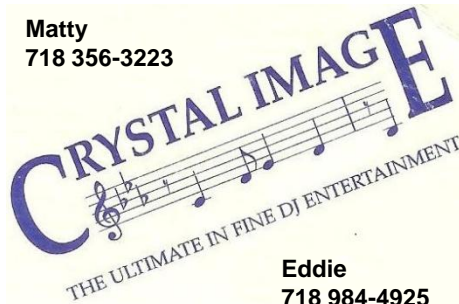
