The Chaplain's Corner

Traditionally, June is the month for brides. Given the way weddings have gotten out of hand when it comes to over the top expenses, most of us priests now find that we witness very few weddings during this month. The new "tradition" seems to be October. One tradition of June that will never be too expensive that June is the month of the Sacred Heart – and though that will never change, it is very much linked to October as the Month of the Rosary.

Like most Irish homes, our house had the well-known double holy picture of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. As a kid, I was fascinated by the fact that, no matter where you were in the room, Jesus was looking directly at you. It seemed that you couldn't hide from Him, and there was no way He wouldn't know what you were doing. The Sacred Heart beat Santa at knowing if you were being naughty or nice!

The ever present gaze of the Sacred Heart can be misconstrued as Jesus out to get you. In reality it is Jesus looking out *for* you; always there whenever you need Him, always with eye to help you, and – yes – always knowing what you're doing. But that always knowing wasn't to determine your Christmas presents. Jesus ever present gaze is one of love that always forgives when we're naughty, and grows when we're nice.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart, expressed beautifully in the writing of St. Margaret Mary Alcoque, reminds us that Jesus not only forgives us no matter what we do – He *wants* to forgive if only we let Him. Sometimes it's hard to let Jesus forgive us. The problem is not Jesus' willingness to forgive – it's our unwillingness to let ourselves be forgiven.

And this is where the other side of that picture in our house as kids comes in. When you're not sure if you should go to your father, you always go to your mother. The best way to let the loving heart of Jesus into our hearts is to open our hearts to the loving embrace of Mary. Faithfulness to the Rosary opens our hearts to the Immaculate Heart, especially at those times when things are so confusing that we don't know what to say. The calming repetition of the Hail Mary reminds us that, no matter how turbulent things are, the prayer of Mary at the confusing moment of the Annunciation will open us to repeat Her "yes" to God's love.

This June, be sure to say your rosary. It's the first thing we receive when we become Brother Knights. It should be in our pocket everywhere we go, and be prayed every day. If we do, then we'll walk confidently in the knowledge that Jesus is always looking out for us.
