From the Chaplain's Desk

My fellow Knights, I could not avoid thinking about you the other day while I was going through a recent copy of L'Osservatore Romano, the official Vatican newspaper. One of the articles was covering the Holy Father's visit to Venice. The way he talked to the people and his warm feelings for them for the way they are working together as the people of God made me think of you guys.

In his address, Pope Benedict XVI said there is a real need for Christians who can *swim against the tide*, to build a *society worthy of man*. The Holy Father said this to the assembly gathered in the Venetian Basilica of San Marco on Sunday afternoon, May 8th, for the closure of the Diocesan Pastoral Visit which began in 2005.

In his address, the Holy Father referred to that Gospel where short little Zacchaeus, a man of wealth and position, scampered up a tree so he could get a better sight of our Blessed Lord. The Holy Father pointed out how our Lord Jesus was aware of him all the time and knew his heart. *I must stay at your house today. So he made haste and received him joyfully (Luke 19:5-6).*

The Pope goes on to say: This is Zacchaeus' experience. According to the current mentality, he has it all: power and money. He can be called a *man who has made it*. He has worked his way up, has achieved what he wanted and could say, like the rich fool in the Gospel parable, *Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years, take your ease, eat, drink and be merry (Luke 12: 19)*. For this reason, his desire to see Jesus is surprising. What impelled him to seek Jesus out? Zacchaeus realized that what he possessed was not enough, he felt the desire for more. Here was Jesus, the prophet of Nazareth, passing through Jericho, his hometown.

Now, my brother Knights, you are so much like Zacchaeus. Each of you has been given various gifts from God yet your thirst for more and better has caused you to join with this Christian body, the Knights of Columbus, to keep you close to the only one who can satisfy that thirst. Your camaraderie in His name; your charitable works in His name; your social activities at the Council in His name and, above all, your gathering together for prayer, especially the highest form of prayer, Holy Mass, is accepting the invitation for closeness to our Lord.

Our Holy Father goes on in his address to say: *Beloved Church in Venice! Imitate the example of Zacchaeus and surpass it! Overtake the men and women of today and help them to surmount the barriers of individualism, of relativism; never let yourselves be brought low by the failures that can scar Christian communities. Strive to look closely at the person of Christ, who said: "I am the way, the truth and the life" (Jn 14: 6).*

I think by now, brother Knights, you can see how you fit into this picture so well. Your striving, your struggling, to see Christ from the vantage point of our Order, will bring you to the surprising invitation, which will show itself in many ways, that our Divine Brother Jesus wants to stay with you.

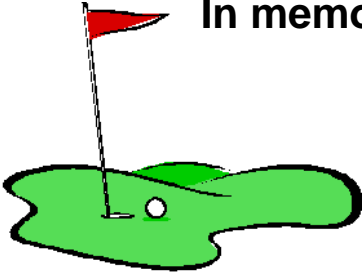

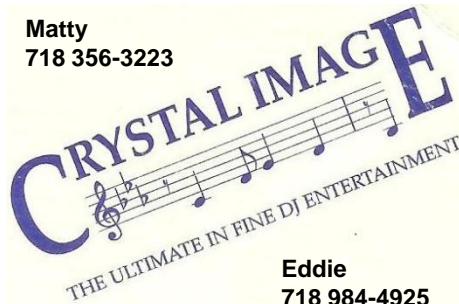
