I am sure I have heard many times parishioners talking to one another: Honey, you've got to lose some weight. But we all know once it gets to that point, it is very difficult. But we also know that it is necessary to protect our natural life.

The same is necessary for our spiritual, supernatural life. We come now to that period of time as Catholics for the need to get back in shape spiritually. There is even a specific time set aside in the Church year to do this: LENT!
