Our Chaplain, Fr. Kostic, has asked that you read the below letter he received from Cardinal Dolan regarding the recent issues with Government run Healthcare and the church.

My brother priest:

I have heard from many of you that the ongoing engagement with the administration over the suffocating HHS mandates continues to be a topic of interest and a source of many questions from your parishioners. So, I wanted to share this information with you, so that you might bring it to the attention of your parishioners in any way that you see fit.

There has been a lot of misinformation surrounding this issue lately. Let me assure what this debate is about and what it is *not* about:

It is about *religious freedom*, pure and simple. It is about the government attempting to force the Church to violate its conscience.


It is *not* about partisan politics. It is not anti-Obama. It is not just a "Catholic" issue. It is not some "bishops' hangup." It is not anti-women's health. It is not, ultimately, about contraception. As one blogger recently commented, "This is no more about contraception than the American Revolution was about tea!"

The HHS mandates are an unwarranted and unprecedented intrusion by the federal government into the internal life of the Church, one that we, joined by many people of other religious faiths, or no faith at all, will continue to oppose. We will continue to seek legislative remedies, as well as justice in the courts. And, we will continue to educate and advocate, so that what is really at stake will not get lost in the rhetoric from those who would seek to portray the Church as out of touch with its people, or simply opposed to health care for women. (That last charge is particularly insulting, given that the Catholic Church has advocated for universal health care for nearly a century, and our record on providing health care to all, particularly to women and children, is second to none. If one were really concerned about the health of women, one would want to protect the integrity of Catholic healthcare, which provides it so well.)

Please know that this fight is not something we bishops sought, and it is not something we relish. All we have asked is that the Church be left alone to continue doing the good work in education, charity, and health care that we have always done, that at least the very narrow and rigid exemption be expanded to include the freedom of religion that this country was founded upon, and that the rights of conscience of the Church and her institutions be protected.

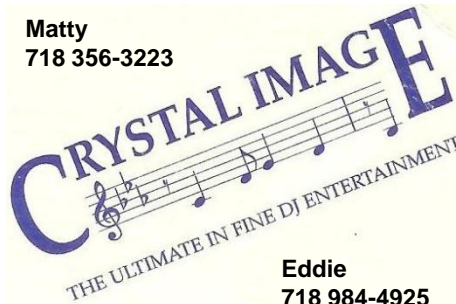
